Description: a non hydrogenated, refined vegetable fat of lauric origin.

Hazards Identification

Eye contact: not aggressive.

Skin contact: essentially non hazardous.

Ingestion: edible quality.

First Aid Measures

Inhalation: not possible in the form in which it is supplied.

Eye contact: accidental contact of oil or fat with eyes should be treated by gentle washing out with warm water.

Skin contact: liquid oil or solid fat accidentally coming into contact with skin poses no hazard. It should be washed off with warm soapy water. If used hot, flush skin with copious amounts of cold water.

Ingestion: Not considered dangerous. Edible quality.

Fire Fighting Measures

Flash point: 315° C (600° F)

Smoke point: 193° C - 232° C (380° F-450° F)

Fire point: 360° C (680° F)

Products are classified as non flammable and are insoluble in water.

Accidental Release Measures

Spillage: ensure area is thoroughly washed with suitable detergent.

Handling & Storage

Handling: normal working hygiene practices should be employed.

Storage: fats should be stored cool and dry, off the floor and away from odorous materials.
